## **Health Care Provider Protection Act** On February 15, the Academy along with 58 health organizations, sent a letter to

Congressional leaders expressing strong support for the reauthorization of the Dr. Lorna Breen Health Care Provider Protection Act (H.R. 7153 / S. 3679). As a result of this law that honors Dr. Lorna Breen's life and legacy, health care workers have had better access to education and training on preventing stress and burnout before the need becomes dire. Reauthorization of the Dr. Lorna Breen Health Care Provider Protection Act will provide federal funding for mental health education and awareness campaigns aimed at protecting the well-being of health care workers. This will help ensure patients and communities continue to have access to high-quality, compassionate, and accessible care.

## Following initial drafting and editing by the Hearing Committee, and review by the Physician Payment Policy (3P) Workgroup, the AAO-HNS Executive Committee approved a new Academy Position Statement on February 15. As outlined, delayed identification of

congenital cytomegalovirus cCMV in newborns precludes timely intervention to mitigate sequelae of the infection such as hearing loss and other neurological complications. Newborn testing for cCMV enables appropriate diagnosis and intervention by multidisciplinary teams to properly manage the immediate consequences of cCMV, avoid unnecessary additional testing that can result from delayed diagnosis, and monitor for future complications. It is the position of the Academy that universal newborn cCMV screening is necessary to best accomplish these goals. **LEARN MORE**


